The Board (club officers) voted to approve the changes, which include placing position descriptions into Policy. This makes the Bylaws easier to read. An Article covering Chairpersons (appointed positions) has been added, as has a Section saying that the VAC will keep its assets if the WBCCI becomes inactive. Members have two means of changing the Bylaws; send a proposed change to the Parliamentarian who will present at the next Membership Meeting, or ask a Board member to sponsor a change at the next Board Meeting.

Proposed changes to the VAC Constitution will be posted on the website very soon, and the membership will vote on these changes at the Sedalia International.

"12x14", The goal to have a VAC rally occur in each region by 2014 now has a full team. They are Jim Cooper, Paul Mayuex, Tom Reed, Bob Novak (Region 2), Iain Cameron (Region 10), and Ken Johansen (Region 11). Vintage Region 1 Rally, August 9—12, 2012


