Left: The TRAILWIND our "baby" model. Size 16' body, 18' overall. Weight right at 1650 lbs., completely furnished. Adequate for four. Same quality furnishings as in our larger models. Very popular with those who really want to "get out and go places."

Center: The ever popular 20' body, 22' overall. Weight averages 2000 lbs. according to the furnishings. This model offers good livability and comes in several floor plans, sleeping 2, 3, or 4 persons.

Right: The AIRSTREAM LIMITED "Unlimited Livability." This brand new model has a 22' body, 24' overall, 7' 10" wide and allows 6' 7" head clearance inside the trailer. Weighs approximately 2800 lbs. completely furnished. WE'RE UP IN THE AIR

We thought it would be a good idea to let you see the construction of the under-belly of the Airstream Liner, without having you get down on your hands and knees. SO WE PUT IT IN THE AIR. Notice that it is also streamlined—that the fine workman-up is just the same as in any other part of the trailercoach. You can see the 6-inch double floor (insulated with spun glass) is completely covered. There isn't much chance, is there, of penetration from cold or dampness.
