- Minutes from 2022 VAC Annual Business Meeting approved as written.
- Treasurer's Report, Tom Kirk: cash balance \$24,128.84.
- Officers' reports
  - President: Chaired 10 board meetings and several subcommittee meetings. Maintained an excellent working and reporting relationship with WBCCI/ACI. Many hours of planning for International.
