

Forrest and Jeri Bone of the Tin Can Tourists Club are among this year's inductees.

Located in Elkhart, Indiana, this prestigious institution is a must-visit for enthusiasts and history buffs.

Celebrating Achievements: Over 480 Inductees

Since its inception in March 1972, the RV/MH Heritage Foundation has honored over 400 industry pioneers and leaders, inducting them into the RV/MH Hall of Fame. Today, more than 480 members' plaques proudly adorn the "Wall of Fame," immortalizing their contributions.

In August 2023, Forrest and Jeri Bone of the Tin Can Tourists Club became the latest inductees of the RV/MH Heritage Foundation Hall of Fame. They will join the ranks of RV inventors, engineers, manufacturers, retailers, suppliers, and RV park operators whose contributions have profoundly shaped the world of RVing in America. Among the distinguished previous inductees are iconic figures in the vintage trailer realm, such as Theodore Bargman,

Don Boles, Wally Byam, John Serro, and many other trailblazers. The 51st annual induction ceremonies at the RV/MH Hall of Fame in Elkhart, Indiana, were well attended by friends and TCT members. Familiar names like Tim Heintz, Dan Piper, Rick and Rose Larson, and David and Mary Gulley gathered from across the US for the "Function at the Junction Rally and Open House" hosted by the Tin Can Tourists. There were over 50 vintage trailers on display. The entire event was a delightful experience. The strong camaraderie among TCT members was unmistakable, undoubtedly fueled by the shared love for vintage camper trailers and inspired by Forest and Jeri Bone. The Bones rekindled the TCT club in 1998 after a hiatus from its inception in 1919. After years with the Airstream club, The Bones envisioned a club that included ALL vintage trailers and RV brands. This weekend was an example of the club's diversity, with trailers ranging from a Holiday House and Bowlus to Vagabonds,

Spartans, and even Airstreams from the Vintage Airstream Club. Despite the warm weekend, participants had the opportunity to cool off and discuss topics like their latest rare trailer finds in one of the large halls adjacent to the camping area.

Monday night was a fantastic dinner followed by the RF/MH HOF ceremonies with Forrest and Jeri formally accepting their award, sporting their "Hall of Famers" green blazers. The 75 or so TCT members, in the room of approximately 500 guests, broke out in the club song, "The More We Get Together," in their honor. Forest and Jeri are one of only a few couples ever to be inducted. Nine other industry leaders from all aspects of the RV and MH industry were also honored at the gala. The recognition of the Bones by the


