We have 45 sites reserved for the rally. All are pull-through sites with full hookups in one area of the campground. We are working on the planning for the rally.



Some of the things we're looking at are:

Buffalo feeding tours ,Golf outing, Bus tour to Crazy Horse and Mount Rushmore, 1880 Steam Train Excursion, A potluck dinner, Happy Hours and campfires, a catered dinner on the last night

You can call and reserve a campsite anytime (do not reserve online). The sites are being held until 2 months before the rally. 2023 costs are ~\$70 per night. There is a weekly rate plus they offer Good Sam, AAA, Military/Veteran, First Responder/Nurse discounts. If you call to reserve a site, let them know you are with the Region 7 Airstream Rally.





## Region 10

We've had a rainy (and sometimes icy) winter here in Oregon so far, so it's hard to imagine the weather being nice enough to get out and camp, but we've made reservations for the Region 10 VAC rally. We have reserved almost a whole loop (25 sites) at Champoeg State Park in the Willamette Valley for **Thursday, July 18, 2024 through Sunday, July 21, 2024 (3 nights)**. If you haven't been to this campground before, you're in for a treat. It's a beautiful park located on the Willamette River. There are biking and walking trails, kayaking, a disc golf course and historical attractions in the park. Evergreen Aviation and Space Museum is less than 30 minutes away and houses the Spruce Goose now. You'll also be minutes away from some wonderful wineries in the north Willamette Valley, if you're interested in wine tasting.

Cost for 3 nights is \$101 for water/electric site and \$107 for full hookups (there are 3 available). These prices include the non-refundable \$8 reservation fee. If you need to cancel you must let us know by July 13th to get your campsite cost refunded!

Meals will be potluck at this point. More information to come as we get closer to the date.

If you want to come we need to get payment from you to hold your spot as soon as you can. We appreciate that since we pay for every site when we make the reservations.

## VAC Caravan Policy

The purpose of this VAC Caravan Policy is to encourage Members of the VAC to develop and host VAC Intra-Club Caravans, and to set forth the manner by which a proposed Caravan is to be submitted for approval by the VAC Board.

All such VAC Intra-Club Caravans, as have been duly approved by the VAC Board (each, a “VAC Caravan”) will be assigned a VAC Caravan Registered Number, using the format “VAC” followed by a sequential number (e.g., VAC-01, VAC-02, et seq.). A running list of numbered VAC Caravans will be maintained on the VAC website and include the VAC Caravan Registered Number, Caravan Name/Theme, Caravan Leader(s), starting and ending dates, locations, and a list of participants, when available.

To be considered for Board approval, each proposal for a VAC Caravan must comply with the following minimum requirements:

The VAC Member(s) who wishes to serve as leader(s) of a VAC Caravan must complete the attached VAC Caravan Form and submit it for review and approval by the Board as soon as practicable but in no event less than 30 days prior to the start date of the proposed VAC Caravan.

A VAC Caravan must be open for participation by all VAC Members. A member of the WBCCI who is not a Member of the VAC may be allowed to participate, if capacity allows, after having given priority participation to VAC Members.

VAC Caravan participants must be selected using a fair and equitable process (e.g., order of application, random drawing, etc.).

A VAC Caravan must have seven (7) or more participating Airstreams.

A VAC Caravan must include a minimum of three (3) or more travel days and overnight camping at four (4) or more locations, which may include the starting and ending points, and time at organized rallies.

VAC Caravans are encouraged to be developed around a theme and will be self-funded.

Each VAC Caravan Leader(s) must certify compliance with the minimum caravan requirements set forth herein.

Upon meeting the minimum requirements noted above, the VAC Board may approve the VAC Caravan and issue a VAC Caravan Registered Number. All decisions whether to approve the VAC Caravan are in the sole discretion of the Board and are final.
