The Raitt Homestead Farm Museum is a 33 acre Farm Museum located in Eliot, Maine. The farm has rolling open space lawn areas for camping and is quiet and rural, while just a few miles away from the Maine and New Hampshire seacoast with many local attractions.

The 1962 Safari is restored to the original floor plan with major updates to systems, frame, and body.
